Terms of Sale

- As noted in these Terms of Sale, "Contractor" shall refer to Certified Electrical Technologies, LLC, trading as Certified Electrical Technologies. "Purchaser" shall refer to the person or entity receiving the products and services as identified on this invoice including the owner of the property identified by this invoice. The signing party represents themselves as being either the "Purchaser" or an authorized agent thereof. The absence of a signature in no way alters either the intent or the specific rights as indicated in the following Terms of Sale.
- 2. All claims or disputes must be within 10 days of the date of this invoice, otherwise the work performed under this contract will be deemed to have been accepted by Purchaser and properly performed in a workmanlike manner under the terms of this contract.
- 3. No returns will be accepted on special order merchandise.
- 4. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25.00 fee.
- 5. Payment Terms are noted on each invoice (computer generated copy) and the Purchaser agrees to abide by these Payment Terms.
- 6. Purchaser agrees to pay a finance charge of 1½% per month (18% per annum) on all overdue balances.
- 7. If applicable, it is the Purchaser's responsibility to provide a Purchase Order Number at the time the work is done.
- 8. In the event that the Purchaser's account is placed for collection, the Purchaser agrees to pay the unpaid balance due (including finance charges), all reasonable costs for collections including attorney fees of 33 1/3% of the unpaid balance due plus court costs.
- 9. The person executing this contract for and on behalf of the Purchaser personally guarantees payment when due of all amounts due Contractor under this contract, including interest and attorneys fees.
- 10. In the event that a balance remains unpaid sixty (60) days from the date on an invoice, Purchaser agrees that the Contractor, at its discretion, may remove any material or equipment that was installed by the Contractor
- 11. This contract is entered into in the state of Maryland and in the event litigation is necessary, the parties consent to jurisdiction in Montgomery County, Maryland.
